COVID-19 metrics in Wake County continue to improve, with the CDC currently classifying the [community levels in our area as “low.”](#)

With this information in mind, Meredith College will officially move to masks optional in most classrooms at 8 a.m. on Monday, March 21. Some faculty may request that students still wear masks while in their classes. Some individuals will continue to request that masks be worn in their private office spaces.

Masks continue to be required in clinical spaces such as Carroll Hall and athletic training rooms, designated spaces in the Learning Center, and childcare facilities.

We recognize that many individuals will continue to wear face coverings for a variety of reasons. If you would like to receive additional high-quality KN95 masks, a limited quantity of these free face coverings is available in the Campus Store on a first-come, first-served basis. Store hours are Monday - Thursday 8:30 a.m. - 5 p.m. and Friday 8:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.
