

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS Summer 2024

Complete this form only after you have registered for your summer classes.

You can begin online registration for summer on March 1, 2024.

Please read carefully the following information about financial assistance for summer school before completing the application form on the reverse side.

Institutional grants and scholarships are not available for the summer sessions. <u>Loans and/or the Federal Pell Grant will be the only source of assistance for summer.</u> Once we receive your application, we will check for eligibility through the Federal Pell Grant Program, Federal Direct Loan Program, the Federal PLUS Loan program (if you are a dependent student) and/or an Alternative Loan program. <u>Detailed information will be sent to your Meredith email address regarding your eligibility</u> for any grant or loan assistance for summer classes.

Please be aware that you may not be eligible for a Federal Direct Loan during the summer even if you received a Direct Loan during the 2023-24 academic year. If you borrowed the annual maximum amount during the regular academic year (fall/spring semesters), or, if your total loan indebtedness has reached program maximums, then you will not have any further eligibility during the summer, unless there is a change in your grade level. If you were eligible for Pell Grant in the Fall or Spring semesters of 2023-24, and you are taking at least 6 credit hours in the summer, you may be eligible for additional Pell Grant in the summer. Because financial assistance for summer sessions is very limited, students are urged to seek other sources of support, including part-time employment on or off campus.

Application Procedures:

STEP ONE: Once you have registered for your summer classes, you will need to submit this Summer Financial Assistance Application to the Office of Financial Assistance.

STEP TWO: Information from your 2023-24 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be used to determine your eligibility for summer aid.

STEP THREE: If you did not submit the 2023-24 FAFSA, you should complete the form online at **www.studentaid.gov** no later than April 1, 2024.

Eligibility for Financial Assistance:

- You must be enrolled in a degree or certificate program, in good academic standing and registered for **at least 6 credit hours** if you are an undergraduate or PBS student, or **3 credit hours** if you are a fully accepted graduate student, to be considered for a Federal Loan.
- If you are not admitted into a degree program and/or will be below half-time status, you could apply for a creditworthy Alternative Loan.
- You must also be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen (as defined by the U.S. Department of Education) and may not be in default on a prior student loan or owe a refund on a federal loan or a federal grant for a previous enrollment period.

Award Notification:

We will email summer financial aid offer letters on a rolling basis as we receive the applications.

PLEASE NOTE: If for some reason you change the number of credits that you will take during the summer sessions, or you change any courses you originally indicated on this application, you must let us know immediately, as it WILL AFFECT your assistance – and may make you ineligible for any financial assistance.
